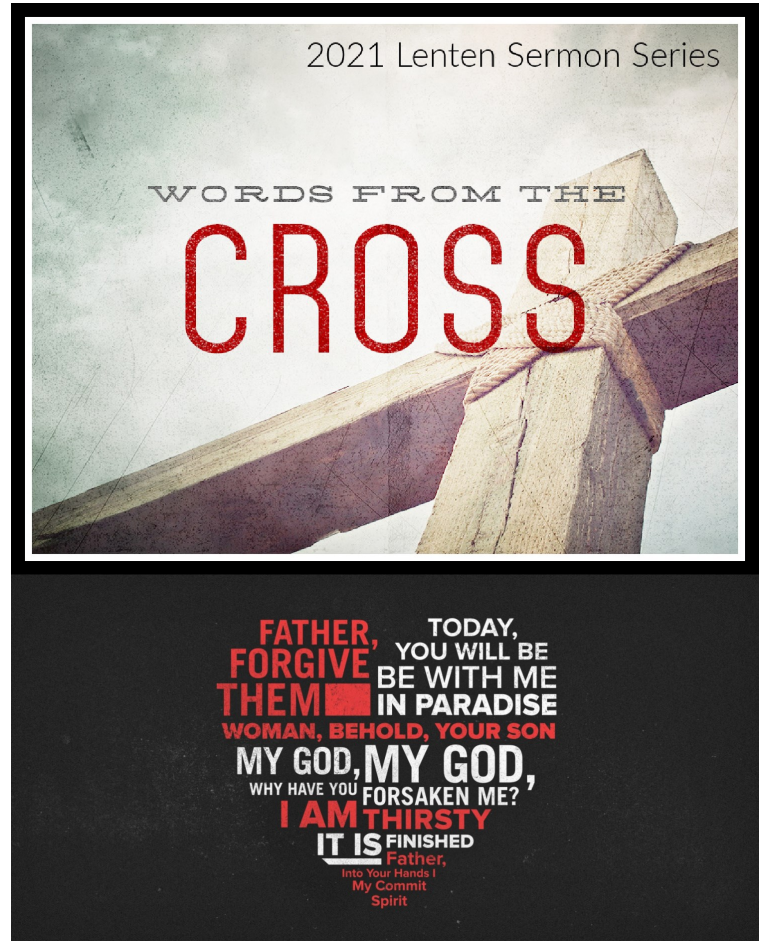

SERMON

"Why Have You Forsaken Me?"
Matthew 27:45-50

From noon until three in the afternoon darkness came over all the land.
