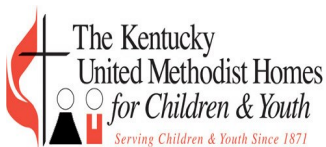

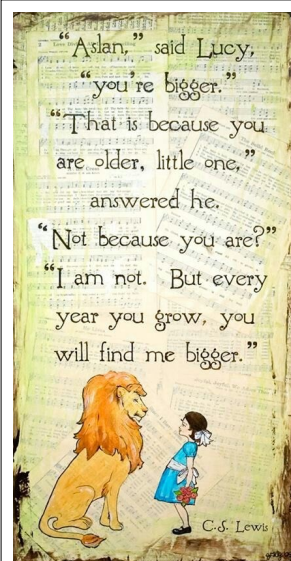
NOTE TIME CHANGE
