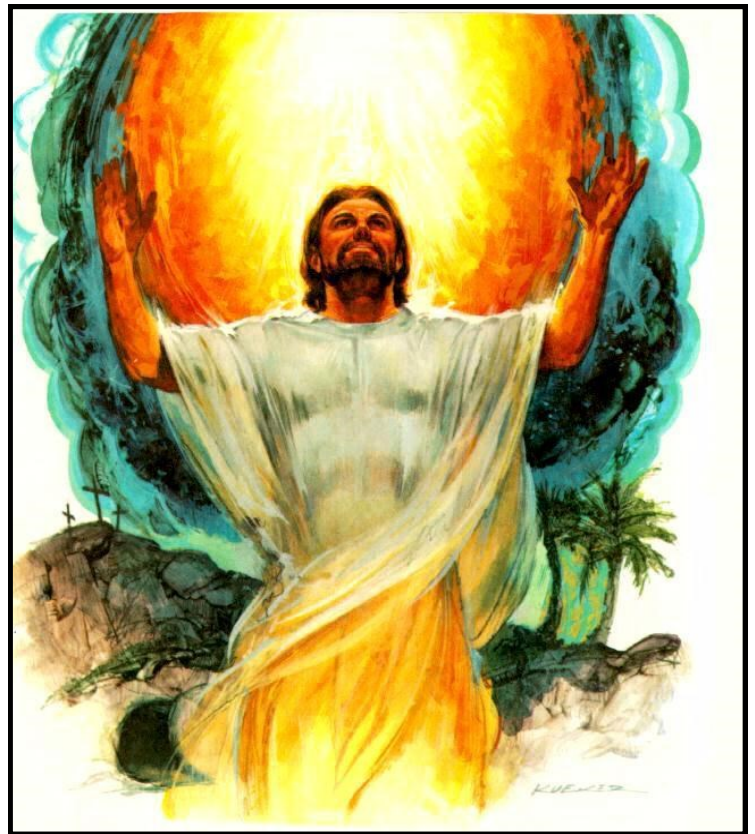

NORTHERN KENTUCKY CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY FACILITY (NKYCAC)

Each year, the United States receives three million reports of suspected child abuse or neglect. This implies that in Northern Kentucky, up to 25,000 children may be impacted by this heinous crime and require assistance from the Northern Kentucky Children's Advocacy Facility (NKYCAC), the region's sole center of its sort. The NKYCAC coordinates responses to child abuse concerns in a child-centered environment by providing prevention, evaluation, and treatment to children and families. For many years, thanks to the leadership of our church member, the late Judy Yoakum, we participated in the Pin Wheel program to benefit the NKYCAC each Spring. We would want to include this worthwhile ministry in our Easter offering this year.



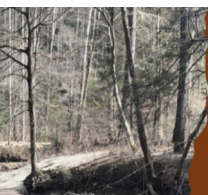
