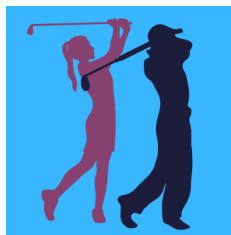

All children in elementary school will move into their new Sunday morning class. Take a moment to locate their class and meet the teacher.



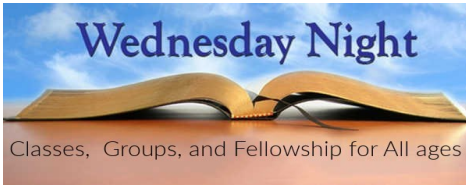
