Below is a note from Cam Gongwer ...

We were able to send a container of medical equipment, supplies and furnishings to the Ankaase Hospital a few months ago. This included exam tables, chairs, neonate beds, dental chairs, ultrasound machines, eye refractor machine, IV poles, microscope and much more. I will send some photos of loading in South Bend and unloading in Ankaase.

The hospital has its first dentist and the dental clinic is active. They are progressing toward opening the training school for dental technicians.

We are hoping to take medical students to Ghana in February for a month long training program in medical missions. We need more students to apply through TMS Global. The COVID pandemic dampened travel interest but that is starting to change.
