2022 / 2023 IMMANUEL VISION and DISCERNMENT TEAM
(Task Team / Subcommittee of the Immanuel Church Council)

At our October meeting the Immanuel Church Council commissioned an ad-hoc “Vision and Discernment Team” to discern God’s will about the direction our congregation should take in the next year (in particular) and also for the next few years. The focus of this team is responding to the turmoil and division in the United Methodist denomination and the potential implications for our Immanuel congregation. The hope is that this special team will be able to offer a prayerfully considered recommendation to the Church Council before the end of this year. Our Church Council will ultimately determine what further actions, if any, to recommend to the congregation as a result. This team has already started meeting weekly, and they are also carefully researching our church’s options, which is very challenging and time-consuming work. They need your prayers (as does our Church Council). If you have questions about the work of this team, please speak to Pastor Kelly or Craig Schwarting. 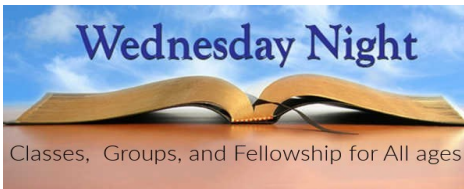

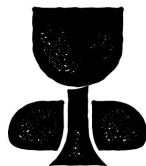

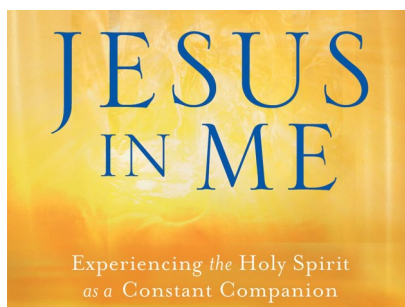


THE IMMANUEL SCHOOL OF MUSIC'S ANNUAL CHRISTMAS WREATH AND CANDLE SALE IS HERE!
