**SENIOR PASTOR'S NOTE ABOUT DISAFFILIATION
CALL TO PRAYER**

DEAR MEMBERS AND FRIENDS OF IMMANUEL,

As you should know by now, our Immanuel congregation voted to disaffiliate from the United Methodist denomination (on February 19, 2023, by a margin of 90%). Our final release still requires a vote of approval by the Kentucky Conference at their annual meeting which is being held in Owensboro this year. The special session for this vote will occur tonight, Sunday, June 4th at 7:00 p.m. Central time (or 8:00 p.m. Eastern).

This Conference vote is expected to be a formality, however, please be in **prayer** for the Conference delegates to officially approve our disaffiliation as well as the 292 other congregations in Kentucky who have also voted to disaffiliate at this conference session. When added to the 80+ churches already approved at previous conference sessions this amounts to 50.5 % leaving the UM denomination in Kentucky.

Please also pray we are all able to move on and amicably go our separate ways in peace. I have many friends and loved ones who are remaining in the UMC for various reasons, so I wish them well and hope they will do the same for us. Please be in prayer for God's will to be done and for Him to be glorified through all of this.

Thank you for your faithfulness to the ministry of Immanuel over the years, and particularly in this past year as we have attempted to gracefully discuss many contentious theological and ecclesial issues. I continue to be very privileged to serve in ministry with this great church family. I love you all.

You will receive an email immediately following the Conference vote to announce the results, and a letter by mail that will also be sent on Monday. That letter will also provide an update about our process to consider new affiliation options leading up to a congregational vote in the coming months.

May God bless you and the ongoing ministry of Immanuel Church.

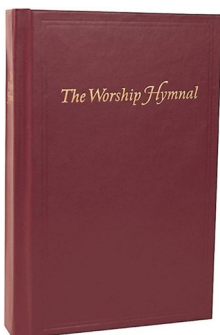

P.S. Immediately following the Kentucky Conference vote, assuming it approves our disaffiliation, we are required to remove any items that include the Cross and Flame logo of the UM denomination. This includes the exterior sign at our Boone Campus, the logo on our Wesley Hall, and our current hymnals and a few other small items. Our new hymnals which will be in place in our Lakeside Park sanctuary on Sunday, June 11th. If you would like one of the old hymnals or would like to search through them to find a dedication for a family member, you are welcome to take one for your personal use. Please notify the church about a time to come and look through them during the month of June. After June, we will donate any remaining to a mission organization. Thank you.



ANNUAL BABY BOTTLE BOOMERANG ENDS FATHER'S DAY SUNDAY, JUNE 18TH

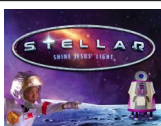

During their monthly meeting in May, the Church Council approved a recommendation to purchase "The Worship Hymnal." This recommendation was made after careful study of several hymnals from both a theological and musical perspective. Additionally, our new hymnal is one that our Sanctuary music team has already been using as a supplemental resource - as such, our musicians already feel comfortable with it.

"The Worship Hymnal" was first published in 2008 by an independent Christian publisher. An ecumenical team of pastors, theologians and musicians were brought together to create this new hymnal at a time when it became apparent that most mainline denominations (of many theological persuasions) were not intending to update their existing hymnals.

"The Worship Hymnal" retains all of the familiar historic and traditional hymns of our faith. Fortunately, many of those hymns are now set in lower keys that will make congregational singing much easier for the typical congregational participant. Additionally, many of the newer hymns that we enjoying singing, like "Ancient Words" and "In Christ Alone," are included in our new hymnal. Each of the hymns in "The Worship Hymnal," has accompanying parts for full orchestra, keyboards and handbells. From a practical perspective, "The Worship Hymnal" is a treasure trove of resources for our music team.
