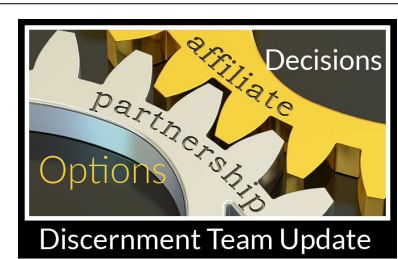


## THE GLOBAL MISSION OF THE CHURCH

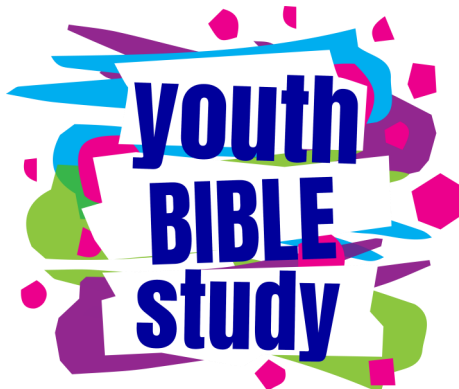
