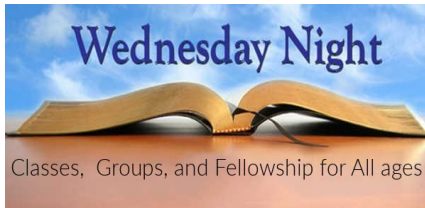

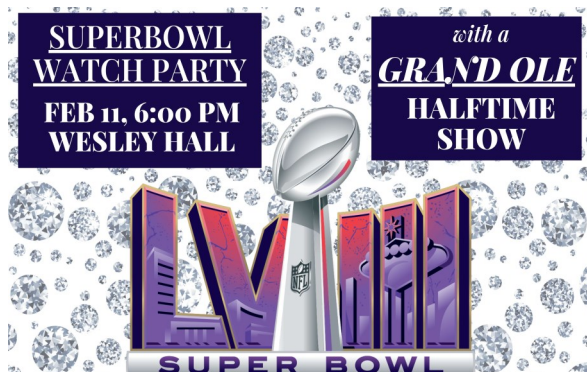
#### YOUTH MIDWEEK FELLOWSHIP

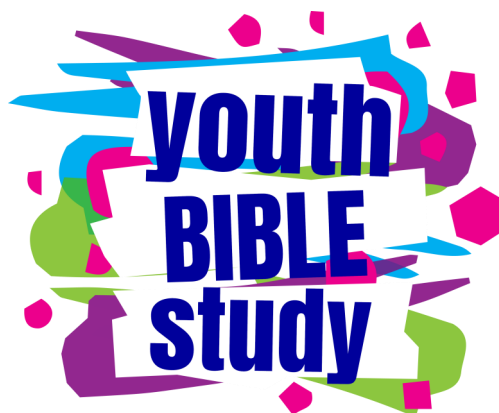
